## Baskets Block of the Month—Quilt Top Assembly

- 1. Square up your 9 blocks and arrange them as desired in a 3 X 3 grid.
- 2. Cut the following fabric:
  - a. Sashing—cut 24 pieces, 10-1/2" x 2-1/2"
  - b. Cornerstones—cut 16 pieces, 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"
  - c. Borders—cut 2 pieces, 38-1/2" x 2-1/2" cut 2 pieces, 42-1/2" x 2-1/2"
- 3. Sew each row of 3 blocks, with a sashing strip on the left side of the first block, a sashing strip between blocks, and a sashing strip on the right side of the third block. You will have 3 rows of: sash/block/sash/block/sash/block/sash.
- 4. Sew the cornerstones and remaining sashing strips together in row. You will have 4 rows of : Stone/sash/stone/sash/stone/sash/stone.
- 5. Sew a cornerstone/sash strip to the top of each sash/block strip. Sew the resulting units together, then sew the last stone/sash strip to the bottom.
- 6. Sew the shorter border strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew the longer border strips to the top and bottom.

## **Finishing**

1. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired and bind.
