## Baskets Block of the Month-Quilt Top Assembly

1. Square up your 9 blocks and arrange them as desired in a $3 \times 3$ grid.
2. Cut the following fabric:
a. Sashing—cut 24 pieces, $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
b. Cornerstones—cut 16 pieces, $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
c. Borders-cut 2 pieces, $38-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
cut 2 pieces, $42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
3. Sew each row of 3 blocks, with a sashing strip on the left side of the first block, a sashing strip between blocks, and a sashing strip on the right side of the third block. You will have 3 rows of: sash/block/sash/block/sash/block/sash.
4. Sew the cornerstones and remaining sashing strips together in row. You will have 4 rows of : Stone/sash/stone/sash/stone/sash/stone.
5. Sew a cornerstone/sash strip to the top of each sash/block strip. Sew the resulting units together, then sew the last stone/sash strip to the bottom.
6. Sew the shorter border strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew the longer border strips to the top and bottom.

## Finishing

1. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired and bind.
