House #2- Left Side Raspberry (AMB 43)	1 - 10 1/2in x 1 3/4in (B) 1 - 10 1/2in x 6 3/4in (C) 2 - 2 1/2in x 3in (D) 1 - 3 1/2in x 3in (E)	1 - 5 1/2in x 1 in (B) 1 - 5 1/2in x 3 1/2in (C) 2 - 1 1/2in x 1 3/4in rectangles (D) 1 - 2in x 1 3/4in rectangles (E)	1 - 3in x 3/4in (B) 1 - 3in x 2in (C) 2 - 1in x 1 1/8in (D) 1 - 1 1/4in x 1 1/8in (E)
House #2 - Right Side Dark Raspberry (AMB 75)	2 - 10 1/2in x 1 3/4in (B) 2 - 2 1/2in x 3in (D) 1 - 3 1/2in x 3in (E) 2 - 4in x 5 1/2in (H)	2 - 5 1/2in x 1 in (B) 2 - 1 1/2in x 1 3/4in rectangles (D) 1 - 2in x 1 3/4in rectangles (E) 2 - 2 1/4in x 3in (H)	2 - 3in x 3/4in (B) 2 - 1in x 1 1/8in (D) 1 - 1 1/4in x 1 1/8in (E) 2 - 1 3/8in x 1 3/4in (H)
Roof - Right Side Light Gray (AMB 5)	1 - 5 1/2in sq (G) 1 - 6in sq, cut in half on the diagonal (F)*	1 - 3in sq (G) 1 - 3 1/2in sq, cut in half on the diagonal (F)**	1 - 1 3/4in sq (G) 1 - 2 1/4in sq, cut in half on the diagonal (F)***
Roof - Left Side Light Blue (AMB 87)	1 - 6in sq, cut in half on the diagonal (F)*	1 - 3 1/2in sq, cut in half on the diagonal (F)**	1 - 2 1/4in sq, cut in half on the diagonal (F)***
House #4 - Left Side Aqua (AMB 33)	1 - 5 1/2in sq (G) 1 - 6in sq, cut in half on the diagonal (F)*	1 - 3in sq (G) 1 - 3 1/2in sq, cut in half on the diagonal (F)**	1 - 1 3/4in sq (G) 1 - 2 1/4in sq, cut in half on the diagonal (F)***
House #4 - Right Side Dark Aqua (AMB 43)	1 - 6in sq, cut in half on the diagonal (F)* 3 - 2in x 3in rectangles (I) 1 - 15 1/2" x 3" (K) 2 - 2 3/4in x 3in (L)	1 - 3 1/2in sq, cut in half on the diagonal (F)** 3 - 1 1/4in x 1 3/4in (I) 1 - 8in x 1 3/4in (K) 2 - 1 5/8in x 1 3/4in (L)	3 - 7/8in x 1 1/8in (I) 1 - 4 1/4in x 1 1/8in (K) 2 - 1 1/8in sq (L) 1 - 2 1/4in sq, cut in half on the diagonal (F)***
Assortment of colors for windows/door	8 - 2in x 3in rectangles (I) 1 - 3 1/2in x 5 1/2in rectangle (J)	8 - 1 1/4in x 1 3/4in (I) 1 - 2in x 3in (J)	8 - 7/8in x 1 1/8in (I) 1 - 1 1/4in x 1 3/4in (J)

Things you need to know:

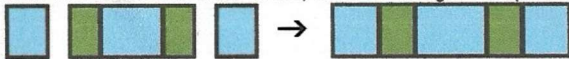
- Each letter for the pieces represents a certain size block. They will be repeated for the left and right sides of the house.
- House numbers (ex. House #1) is on a coloring sheet available in PDF format on my blog.
- Right sides together is (RST)
- When cutting your squares in half to make half-square triangles (hsts), save any leftover halves for future blocks.
- Square assembled hst to:
 - * 5 1/2in sq (throw size)
 - ** 3in sq (wall-hanging size)
 - *** 1 3/4in sq (mini size)
- Press all seams open.

Window Units:

House #2

To make one window unit, sew an (I) to each of the short sides of (E). Then sew a (D) to each of the sides of both (I) pieces. Press open

Make 1 for the left side of the house, and 1 for the right side. (4 total).



House #4

To make one window unit, start with a window (represented in green) (I), and sew 3 additional window (I) pieces, and 3 House #4 (I) pieces, making sure to alternate every other one. Then sew an (L) to each end. Press open. Make 1



Sew (K) to the top of the window unit. Press open.

Sew an aqua (G) to the left side and press.



Roof:

To make the roof, gather and arrange your (F) hsts and (G) pieces. Notice in the house diagram that aqua is used on the left side and dark aqua is on the right side.

After you have arranged your pieces, start assembling your hsts. Sew two hsts (RSTs) along the diagonal edge. Press open and square to *, **, or ***.



Sew (F) and (G) pieces together to create the roof.



Door:

Sew an (H) to each side of (J). Press.



Assembly:

Assemble and sew together the left and right sides of House #2 (pink). Sew the roof to the top.

Sew House #4 window unit to the top.
