Putting the Quilt together

Materials:

Background: all connector strips will be cut 3 ½" wide. You will need about 90" cut into various lengths. Be a little generous when cutting, you can always trim. Cut two - 9 ½", two -12 ½", one -18 ½", one -15 ½", one -11 ½"

Directions for Assembly:

- 1. Use the diagram and picture provided to lay out and join your blocks.
- 2. This is just one method to construct the quilt. Lay out your blocks like the diagram, fill in open areas with
- 3. connector strips. Sew two connector strips to January's Button Tree. Sew the Yo-Yo Tree block, the Button Tree block and the Fruit Tree block together.
- 3. Sew two connector blocks to Grandma's Tree. Sew it to the Bird Condo. Attach Tree of Life block.
- 4. Sew the Acorn and Leaf block to the Maple Leaf block. Attach the Bird's on a Branch block. Add two connector blocks and then the Topiary block.
- 5. Sew the final connector to the Pine Tree block. Sew together with the large block from Step 4.
- 6. Re-lay the quilt using the diagram. Sew together the large block from Step 3 to the Step 5 block.
- 7. Add the Step 2 block.
- 8. Press gently.

Embellishment:

- 1. Add borders, as few or as many as you like.
- 2. Add tree branches, different leaves, or new birds to the borders.
- 3. Quilt using leaf motifs and variegated thread.
