Philanthropy, Monica Shafer and Julie Vlahos – July's meeting of the '**Stash Busters**', our philanthropy friendship group, will support the San Clemente Presbyterian outreach program. In August the group will be making pillowcases for the One Million Pillowcase Challenge. **Stashbusters** group meet at A Time to Sew on the 4th Monday of each month from 10am to 4pm. This month's meeting is on Monday, June 28th.

Monica had several interesting fund raising ideas. One was a bra deco contest possibly in October to coincide with Breast Cancer Awareness Month with the bras to be raffled at the November Fest. Nancy Ota raised the concern about not diluting the November fund raiser as it is intended to be the guild's primary fundraising event. However, the concept was warmly received and the discussion turned to the function of the Opportunity Quilt program. As there is currently a vacancy in October, Monica will come up with a quilt in theme (perhaps including decorated bras!) and have aromatherapy eye masks to sell as the **October Opportunity Quilt** with the funds raised going to Susan G. Komen for the Cure.

Publicity & Sponsors, Kathie Bellamy: Kathie has several new ideas she would like considered: 1) advertising in the form of labels with the guild information adhered to quilting magazines and then left in local doctors & hospital waiting rooms, hair & nail salons, etc. 2) flyers, for example, a fixed flyer to post in quilt shops and on community bulletin boards, and 3) guild business cards or laminated 'book mark' with speakers names to be available at Quilter's Run, OC Fair, SCCQG, etc. Currently there is no budget for publicity. Kathie to investigate the cost and would try to have something available soon. Nancy Ota noted that the cost of printing 1000 Guild Membership Cards was \$54. Kathie provides OC Register's Sun Post, Sun Times, Dana Point Times, & the Capistrano Dispatch with upcoming speaker/meeting each month.

A discussion about a Guild Facebook Page followed. Motion to create a SQG Facebook Page was made by Monica Shafer. Second was made by Joann Bishop. A voice vote resulted in 9 in favor, 6 opposed, the rest undecided. **Motion carried.** Kathie will create the Guild Facebook Page, and Monica Shafer will 'chatter'.

Monthly Quilt Exhibit, Maggie Bell: Maggie requested that photos of all the completed quilt tops of 'Surfs Up' BOM quilts and their respective maker be compiled into a booklet. Maggie will coordinate with Nancy Ota to have a sign-up sheet available at July guild to collect names of those interested in purchasing this booklet and for how much.

Southern California Council of Quilt Guilds (SCCQG): Nancy Ota has been working with Council on the details for the summer quarterly meeting entitled "Meet the Teachers" to be held on Saturday, July 10 at 10 AM. We are the hosting this July meeting of Council. **Leann Goettel** has enough volunteers to bring food for breakfast. **Barbara Ann Christensen** will be requesting volunteers to help direct the visitors from parking in the lots and on the street to the elevator (if needed) and directing visitors to the meeting location. We can expect 100+ people. SQG is a member of SCCQG and by extension so are SQG members. Surfside QG members are welcome to attend.
